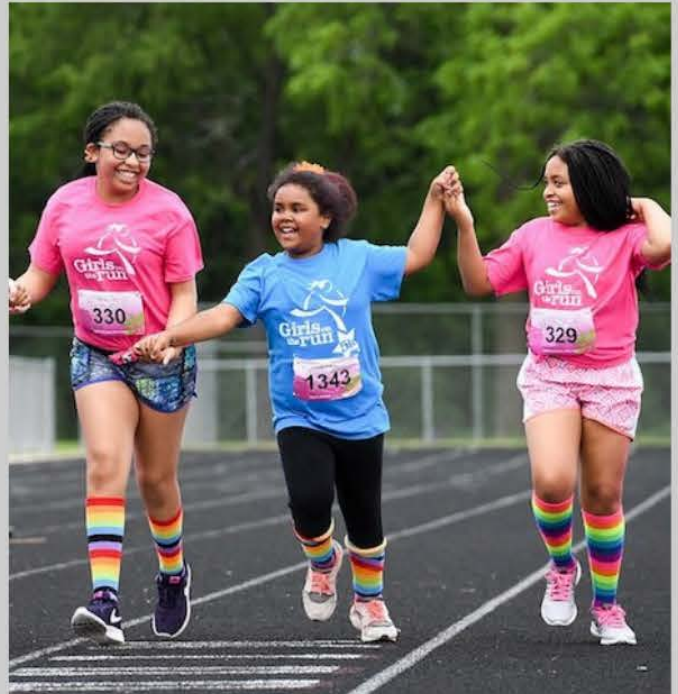


The Joan Hanson Foundation
